The Director of Veterinary and Clinical Services is responsible to provide a high-quality animal care and use program and ensures that services provided by the Comparative Medicine and Animal Resources Centre (CMARC) personnel meet or exceed established national and international quality standards for laboratory animal care, including Canadian Council of Animal Care (CCAC) guidelines, and university policies and standard operating procedures. This position provides leadership and direction to the clinical veterinarians, animal health technicians, animal welfare administrators and training administrators The Director, Veterinary and Technical Services reports to the Associate Vice Principal, Animal Care/University Veterinarian and works in close collaboration with the Director of Administration and Operations, CMARC, and the Director of the Office of Animal Compliance (ACO).
